

# Specific Procurement Notice Request for Bids Small Works

(One-Envelope Bidding Process)

**Country:** Saint Vincent and the Grenadines

1. The Government of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines (hereinafter called “Borrower”) has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Volcanic Eruption Emergency Project (VEEP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for **Small Works: The construction of water reservoirs, reservoir measures and the construction of administration and electrical buildings for CWSA (Lot 3).**
2. The Ministry of Finance, Economic Planning and Information Technology (hereinafter called “MFEPIT”), an implementing agency of the Borrower now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for the Small Works: The construction of water reservoirs, reservoir measures and the construction of administration and electrical buildings for CWSA (Lot 3). **The two reservoirs will have a storage volume of 236,000 Ig at Overland and 40,000 Ig at Point Village, will be in concrete material and fitted with inlet, outlet, overflow, washout and ventilation pipes and valves, as well as field instruments (electromagnetic outlet flowmeter and ultrasonic level meter), electric panel and solar PV power supply. The rehabilitation measures at the existing water reservoirs of Sandy Bay and Sion Hill will consist mainly of works at the existing inlet and outlet of the reservoirs. The administration building construction, with an approximate floor area of 102m<sup>2</sup>, will be fitted with a control room, warehouse, office and water operator facilities. The electrical building, with an approximate surface of 65m<sup>2</sup>, will house the electrical equipment and an emergency diesel generator. The estimated duration of the works is 14 months.**
3. Bidding will be conducted through international competitive procurement using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank’s “Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers” (5<sup>th</sup> edition September 2023) (“Procurement Regulations”), and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
4. Interested eligible Bidders may obtain further information from the Economic Planning Division of the Ministry of Finance, Economic Planning and Information Technology using the email addresses as stated below and inspect the bidding document during office hours *Monday – Friday: 8:00am – 4:00pm* at the address given below.

5. The bidding document in English may be obtained by interested eligible Bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address given in paragraph nine (9) below. The document will be sent by email.
6. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before **1.30 pm** (local SVG Time) on **July 25, 2025**. Electronic bidding will be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the address below on **2.00 pm** (Local SVG Time) on **July 25, 2025**.
7. All Bids must be accompanied by a by a Bid-Securing Declaration.
8. Attention is drawn to the Procurement Regulations requiring the Borrower to disclose information on the successful bidder's beneficial ownership, as part of the Contract Award Notice, using the Beneficial Ownership Disclosure Form as included in the bidding document.
