The consulting services (“The Services”) are for the day-to-day management, coordination and implementation of the Data for Decision Making Project, in Saint Vincent and the Grenadines. The Project Coordinator will work in close collaboration with the Chief Statistician as well as the key participating ministries within the GoSVG, and with the World Bank project team. The Services will include planning and project implementation activities, and the management of project staff efforts in project planning, preparation, and execution.
